## SENIORS CONGRESS

1 - 3 November 2013

This congress, held at the Daventry Hotel in Northamptonshire, is for players who were born in 1953 or earlier.

It features: a four-session Championship Pairs; a one-day Swiss Pairs for those who wish to start play on the Saturday as well as for those who fail to qualify for the main Championship Pairs finals; and a two-session Swiss Teams on the Sunday.

*In response to feedback from players last year, those who qualify for the main semi-final of the Championship Pairs will carry forward their first session score. There will be no carry-forward to the secondary semi-final, and it will be possible to qualify for the final from either semi-final.*

## NATIONAL TEAMS CONGRESS – new format for 2014

18 – 19 January 2014

A new format for 2014! A pair of events running in parallel: Point-a-Board teams (with enhanced master points) for those who wish, or Swiss Teams for those who prefer. Teams who fail to qualify at the end of the second session for Sunday's main Point-a-Board final may join the Swiss Teams with a carry-forward score, or can continue playing Point-a-Board in a secondary final. Ideal for players wishing to add to their Green Point tally. Thirteen 7-board matches are played in all in the Swiss Teams, eight on Saturday and five on Sunday. Point-a-Board format subject to numbers, but at least as many boards as the Swiss Teams.

We now run EBU games with masterpoints, on [Bridge Base Online \(BBO\)](#). They are open to anyone, not just EBU members, although they are specifically aimed towards our members by issuing EBU masterpoints and using EBU regulations.

These games are every Wednesday at 4pm and 11pm, and every Sunday at 4pm, 6pm and 9pm.

We hope that this will cater to a range of our members without taking them away from their regular face-to-face club games in clubs. This schedule may be expanded once the games are more established.
