## THE NATIONAL TEAMS CONGRESS

17th - 18th January 2015, near Birmingham

---

### A pair of events running in parallel: Point-a-Board or Swiss Teams You decide which one to enter

The parallel competitions were introduced for 2014 and proved popular. Both events run concurrently and you choose at the start which you wish to enter.

There will be a qualifying multiple-teams on Saturday in the Point-a-Board prior to Sunday's main final, which features longer head-to-head matches. Those failing to qualify for the Point-a-Board final may join the Swiss Teams on Sunday with a carry forward score, or can continue playing Point-a-Board in a secondary final. Alternatively you can play in the Swiss teams throughout the weekend.

The Point-a-Board competition carries enhanced Green Points in both the qualifying rounds and final. The Point-a-Board is also part of the **Championship Series** in which points can be won for the [Player of the Year Championship](#)

Green Points are awarded in the Swiss Teams at the standard rate.

Those unfamiliar with Point-a-Board matches may wish to read [this short guide](#), David Gold's guide to the tactics of PAB in the [June 2013 issue of English Bridge](#), or read Brian Senior's [discussion of the different tactics](#) for Point-a-Board, IMPs and Match Points.

The venue is the Holiday Inn close to Birmingham airport, so there are great transport links to the rest of the country. The hotel also runs a complimentary shuttle service to Birmingham International railway station.

Trains to central Birmingham take 12 minutes, run approximately every ten minutes, and cost as little as £3 return.

Parking is available free at the hotel for residents, and for non-residents at a public carpark 200m away for £2.50 (when displaying a sign obtained from the hotel reception).

The congress begins on Friday afternoon with mixed and open pairs events, with the Swiss Pairs starting in the evening. This continues throughout Saturday with nine 8-board matches played across the weekend.

Sunday has a seven round Swiss Teams event.

Both Swiss events are fully Green Pointed. The Mixed/Open Pairs are Blue Pointed on the national congress scale.

The closing date for entries is 6th February 2015 but **early entry is advised** as the congress may be full before that date.
