NATIONAL TEAMS CONGRESS

16th - 17th January, Holiday Inn,
Birmingham Airport

Choose from Swiss or Point-a-Board Teams events

The third year with this new format - a pair of events running in parallel - Point-a-Board teams or Swiss Teams. You choose which version of the event you wish to enter.

There will be enhanced masterpoints in the Point-a-Board teams and it is also part of the Championship Series, in which points can be earned towards the [Player of the Year Championship](#).

There will be a qualifying multiple-teams on Saturday in the Point-a-Board prior to Sunday's main final, which features longer head-to-head matches. Those failing to qualify for the Point-a-Board final will join the Swiss Teams on Sunday with a carry forward score. Those who prefer can play in the Swiss teams throughout the weekend.

The **Masters Pairs** is open to players below the rank of Regional Master: Local Masters, Club Masters, Area Masters, District Masters, County Masters, Masters, Advanced Masters, Star Masters, Tournament Masters or Premier Masters. Members who have attained a [landmark promotion](#) to the rank of Master are entitled to free entry.

All venues will play the same boards and the event will be scored across the entire field. The top 50 pairs nationally will qualify to play in the National Final. Should any pair be unable to play in the National Final, their place will be taken by the next-ranked pair.

In addition a ranking list will be produced from each region (scored by itself), with the winning pairs being awarded the regional trophies.

The National Final will take place near Birmingham on the weekend of 16th and 17th April 2016.

The event is part of the **Championship Series**, in which points can be earned towards the [Player of the Year Championship](#).
