The London event includes a three session Championship Pairs, a flighted Swiss Pairs and a Stratified Swiss Teams. An early start is available on Friday for the Championships Pairs - if you wish to start at 2pm rather than the standard 4pm please let us know when entering.

The Northern Easter Festival, run by the Yorkshire CBA on the EBU's behalf, starts with an Open Pairs and a Mixed Pairs competition, continues with a three session Swiss Pairs, and ends with a Swiss Teams. They will also host an improver pairs which is part of the Really Easy Afternoon (see below).

The Under 21 Championship Pairs is part of the Easter Festival in London. Entry is free (please enter in advance), and players also gain free entry to the Swiss Teams, and half price entry to the Swiss Pairs.
