The English Bridge Union (EBU) has launched a funded scheme to bring Minibridge into the school classroom over the next three years and we are coming into your area.

Minibridge is a simplified version of the card game of bridge and has proven suitable for classroom use, allowing children the opportunity to improve their logical and lateral thinking skills within the framework of play, which offers dynamic brain training.
