

P2P Charge Rates Club Information

On 1st July 2011 the EBU extended its system of P2P Charge Rates for files submitted through the online P2P system to accommodate some different events and to make submissions more descriptive for accounting purposes. For most clubs the main difference is that any zero-rated events will need to have a more specific code. The following table lists the charge rates that are applicable to clubs.

Rate	Description
02	Null Session. Used only for sessions that are not played e.g. to award Master Points for a final ladder. No charge will be made and no sessions credited to the participants i.e. this will not form a credit for a magazine point.
03	A club's annual (once per EBU financial year) free session e.g. for a Christmas party or AGM. We don't need further details, but a meaningful description would be helpful if there are any queries.
04	Teaching/supervised play session where 16 or fewer boards are played. Free of charge.
06	Children in Need Simultaneous Pairs. Free of charge.
10	Normal P2P club session charged at the standard EBU rate for the date it was played, plus any county charges.
22	Approved novice session. Half the P2P price.

Prices

Exact prices are not discussed here as these vary according to when the session was played. For example, a club session played on 31/03/2011 will be charged at the 2010/11 rate (29p) regardless of when the session is actually submitted to us.

Scoring Systems

Scoring system authors have been made aware of these changes and should have updated their software to allow clubs to submit these new rates. You will also be able to select the charge rate at the time of submission, through the website.
