

P2P Charge Rates

On 1st July 2011 the EBU extended its system of P2P Charge Rates for files submitted through the online P2P system to accommodate some different events and to make submissions more descriptive for accounting purposes. The following table lists the charge rates that are applicable.

Rate	Description
02	Null Session. Used only for sessions that are not played e.g. to award Master Points for a final ladder. No charge will be made and no sessions credited to the participants i.e. this will not form a credit for a magazine point.
03	A club's annual (once per EBU financial year) free session e.g. for a Christmas party or AGM. We don't need further details, but a meaningful description would be helpful if there are any queries.
04	Teaching/supervised play session where 16 or fewer boards are played. Free of charge.
05	Specially exempt District League one-day event. Free of charge.
06	Children in Need Simultaneous Pairs. Free of charge.
10	Normal P2P club session charged at the standard EBU rate for the date it was played, plus any county charges.
20	County event up to 31/03/2012. Free of charge.
20	County event from 01/04/2012. Half the P2P price.
21	League or knockout event from 01/04/2012. Half the P2P price. Used for club, county, district or regional leagues and knockouts.
22	Approved novice session. Half the P2P price.
30	Licensed affiliated event (swiss or non-swiss).
40	Affiliated charity event (swiss or non-swiss).
50	Affiliated/associated blue-pointed event, from 01/01/2013
60	County green-pointed event.
70	Event run by a registered commercial (i.e. non-affiliated) operator in England.
71	Event run by a registered commercial (i.e. non-affiliated) operator outside of England.

Prices

Exact prices are not discussed here as these vary according to when the session was played. For example, a club session played on 31/03/2011 will be charged at the 2010/11 rate (29p) regardless of when the session is actually submitted to us.

Scoring Systems

Scoring system authors have been made aware of these changes and should have updated their software to allow clubs to submit these new rates. You will also be able to select the charge rate at the time of submission, through the website.
