

EBU Club Liaison and County Working Groups

There is a dedicated Club Liaison Officer and a network of volunteer County, Regional and National Club Representatives who can be contacted for advice or to pass on information, suggestions and requests to the EBU. As of July 2019, the EBU Club Liaison Officer is Jonathan Lillycrop.

Club Liaison Officer

The Club Liaison Officer (CLO) is a full-time member of EBU staff whose responsibility is to provide advice and information to clubs. If he doesn't know the answer himself, he will usually know someone who can help.

In order to keep in touch with the membership, provide clubs with advice on new developments and best practice, and make sure that clubs are getting the most from their membership of the EBU, the CLO undertakes regular visits to clubs around the country.
