1 Introduction

Welcome to the Westhill Country Hotel and to the Lambourne Jersey Festival of Bridge. Please keep this programme with you over the time that you are attending the Congress as your reference to the various arrangements that will apply to each session.

2 Bridgemates

North (or South) is responsible for entering the contract & result into the Bridgemate, and East (or West) must be shown it to verify its accuracy by pressing the ACCEPT button.

It is best to enter the contract, declarer and lead at the end of the auction – this saves time, reduces the risk of entering the wrong board number, and ensures the lead is fresh in your mind.

Entering the lead accurately not only provides extra information of interest to players, but can also assist the scorer in resolving errors of data-entry.

It is an offence to attempt to access the TD screen or change a score in the Bridgemate without calling the TD.

Bridgemate UK is the EBU's "Official Wireless Scoring Provider"

3 Trophies and awards

The Channel Islands Trophy for the winners of the Swiss Pairs Championship.

The St Helier Trophy for the leading non-expert pair in the Swiss Pairs Championship.

The Shell Trophy for the best performance by members of the CICBA in the Swiss Pairs Championship.

The Zenith Trust Group Trophy for the winners of the Seniors Pairs.

The Douglas Romain Claret Jug to the best CICBA pair in the Seniors Pairs.

The Jersey Tourism Trophy for the winners of the Multiple Teams.

The Mary Ann Trophy for the winners of the Championship (Open) Pairs.

The Collins Trophy for the winners of the Mixed Pairs.

The Fox Cup to the highest placed Channel Islands pair in the Mixed Pairs.

The Laing & Cruickshank Trophy for the winners of the Swiss Teams Championship.

The Lambourne Cup for the best performance by members of the CICBA in the Swiss Teams Championship.

4 Prizes

Tied places share equally any prizes due even if the tie has been split for purpose of awarding the trophy. Prizes for first place only, per pair or per team, as follows:

Championship (Open) Pairs	£40	Seniors Pairs	£60
Mixed Pairs	£40	Swiss Pairs	£80
Multiple Teams	£60	Swiss Teams	£80

5 Master Point awards

For Green Point events, awards for intermediate places in accordance with the standard EBU congress formula.

5.1 Swiss Pairs Championship

0.28 Green Point per match won (0.14 for a draw).

Bonus Green Point awards to the top quarter of the field as follows:

1st 2.50 last award receiving position 0.50.

5.2 Swiss Teams Championship

0.28 Green Point per match won (0.14 for a draw).

Bonus Green Point awards to the top fifth of the field as follows:

1st 2.00 last award receiving position 0.50.

5.3 Seniors Pairs

Green points to half the field as follows: 1st 2.00 last award receiving position 0.50.

5.4 All other events

Blue Points are awarded on Regional Scale (3 x club awards). In single session events, these are awarded to the top one-third of the field.

6 Miscellaneous

- a) You are required to have a pair of identical completed convention cards and you should exchange them with your opponents at the start of each round. If you do not have two completed convention cards, you may be provided with an EBU Simple System card and required to play it.

All competitions in this event are Level 4: **you may not use WBF convention cards**, which are only permitted in EBU Level 5 events.

- b) Best Behaviour at Bridge – please be nice to your partner, be pleasant to your opponents and be polite to the Tournament Directors. Otherwise you may well be given a Disciplinary Penalty!
- c) Please switch off your mobile phone. If you must have it on for emergencies, switch it to silent and leave the playing area before answering it. You may not use any electronic equipment within the playing room for texting, emailing or otherwise communicating.
- d) You may not use electronic cigarettes in the playing room.
- e) All prizes will be automatically credited to the member's EBU account, and may be redeemed at any time on application to the EBU.

The prize values quoted assume a certain level of entry, and are subject to alteration should the actual entry be significantly different from that originally envisaged. An appropriate announcement would be made before the half-way stage of the tournament in question should this eventuality arise.

- f) Pairs who require teammates should register their names on the appropriate notice. Whilst every effort will be made to match pairs together, we regret that no guarantee can be given in this matter.

If, having registered yourselves as requiring teammates, you subsequently manage to make arrangements, it is essential that you delete your names from the noticeboard.

- g) Channel Island trophies will only be awarded to pairs, both members of which are bona-fide residents of and registered members of the CICBA.

Similarly, in teams competitions all members of the team must be both bona-fide residents of and registered members of the CICBA.

- h) The terms and conditions of contest outlined in this or any previously published programme may be varied upon the express instruction of the Chief Tournament Director of the event in order to facilitate the smooth running of the Congress should any unforeseen circumstance arise. For instance, if numbers require, re-matches will be allowed in the final session of the Swiss teams.
