

'Level 2' are the regulations for permitted agreements for lower flight events. They allow common English systems but do not allow artificial bids which may be weak. This is a summary of common agreements, systems and conventions which are or are not allowed at 'Level 2'.

Landy, Astro in defence to 1NT: at least one suit specified	Two-level overcalls of 1NT without one specified suit

Any leads, signals and discards with a single simple meaning	Dual meaning signals; and encrypted carding methods
