## In Memoriam

**ALISON BURT** (Kent): Sadly we report the death of Alison Burt who for many years kept the KCBA web site up to date, rounding up results and successes of Kent players for the news columns in this magazine. Alison played at several clubs in Kent and was an active member of Farnborough (Kent) Bridge Club, serving on the committee as both Chairman and President. She also found time to organise charity bridge events and was well known for her delicious homemade cakes. Alison was a lovely lady and will be missed by all who knew her.

**MIKE WEBBER** (Sussex): The Sussex County Management Committee is very sad to report the death of Mike Webber after a short illness. Mike joined Chichester Bridge Club in 1987. He became a member of the club committee in 1990 and since then worked tirelessly as director, newsletter editor, organiser/communicator, consultant on bridge matters, handyman and devoted all-round servant of the club. When Chichester Bridge Club moved premises and took a licence on property at the Bishop Luffa School, Mike was active in assisting with the construction and fitting out the new

building. Without him the club would not have the premises they have today.

Mike ran his own bridge classes and supported the teaching and development of new members. He remained a loyal member of the committee for more than 25 years and as senior director was always ready to step in and help. Until recently he was also a leading contributor to the hugely popular overseas bridge holidays run by Mercian.

Mike was an experienced bridge director (at national level for very many years) and helped to train and support new directors at Chichester Bridge Club. He was always there to guide and mentor with his calm, authoritative manner. His knowledge of the rules was legendary and any disputes or queries at the table were swiftly and pleasantly resolved to the satisfaction of all.

Mike's exceptional contribution to Sussex bridge over so many years was recognised in 2013 with the award of the Gladys Hakki trophy, a richly deserved reflection of his devotion to the members of Chichester Bridge Club and to the hundreds of others who learned and played the game under his direction and supervision. We will all miss him greatly. □
