YEAR END CONGRESS

Shed that sluggish feeling from one too many mince pies, and too much Christmas TV by playing in one of our Year End Congresses. Enjoy festive bridge in excellent settings and finish your bridge in 2013 on a high.

BLACKPOOL

28 - 30 December 2013

This congress has earned the reputation of being relaxed and friendly, and is ideal for players entering a national congress for the first time.

There is a pairs event on the first afternoon, a three-session Swiss Pairs across the first evening and second day, and finishes with a Swiss Teams on the final day.

For 2013 only the congress will be held in the elegant setting of the historic Imperial Hotel, located on The Promenade and within walking distance of the town's attractions.

This congress offers 'stratified' tournaments, so caters for all standards, from improver to elite, ensuring an enjoyable congress for all.

There is a stratified Swiss Pairs across the first two days, and a stratified Swiss Teams on the fourth day. Mixed and open pairs competitions take place on the third day.

NATIONAL TEAMS CONGRESS – new format for 2014

18 – 19 January 2014

A new format for 2014! A pair of events running in parallel: Point-a-Board teams or Swiss Teams.

You choose which version of the event you wish to enter. There will be a qualifying multiple-teams on Saturday in the Point-a-Board prior to Sunday's main final, which will feature longer head-to-head matches. Those failing to qualify for the Point-a-Board final may join the Swiss Teams on Sunday with a carry forward score, or can continue playing Point-a-Board in a secondary final. Alternatively you can play in the Swiss teams throughout the weekend.

This congress will be ideal for players wishing to add to their Green Point tally and there will be enhanced masterpoints in the Point-a-Board teams.

YORK SPRING CONGRESS

28 February – 2 March 2014

This congress replaces the Harrogate Spring Congress in 2014. The Spring Congress will return to Harrogate in 2015.

This popular congress moves to York for one year only. Make the most of the opportunity to play bridge in the city of the Minster and The Shambles.

There is a pairs event on the first afternoon, a three-session Swiss Pairs across the first evening and second day, and finishes with a Swiss Teams on the final day.

Both Swiss events are fully Green Pointed. The Mixed/Open Pairs are Blue Pointed on the national congress scale.

The closing date for entries is 12th February 2014 but early entry is advised as this congress may be full before that date.

REMINDERS

Simultaneous Pairs Events

Ahead of a new year of EBU-organised Simultaneous Pairs events we wanted to alert you to a number of aspects of the competitions.

New prize structure: There is a new prize structure for 2014. There are cash prizes for the overall winners of each event, and each heat winner, and each hosting club, will also have the chance to win up to £1000.

The hands: We have received feedback that some people are concerned that hands in a Sims event are manipulated so that they are 'weird'. This is not true. The hands you receive are exactly as dealt.

The results: The results service which is provided is excellent, with a breakdown of all the scores and percentages along with hand records and an expert commentary which is both interesting and educational. Here is an example

Masterpoints: Enhanced masterpoints will be awarded so it is therefore an excellent opportunity for those who are seeking a promotion to a higher rank. In addition, the leading pairs nationally will also be awarded **Blue Points.** You can find out more about Blue Points here

We hope that you will be keen to take part and will encourage your club to host a heat.

National Pairs Heats

If you wish to enter the National Pairs your club can host a heat. Heats can be hosted by any EBU affiliated club, and the heats can be part of an ordinary club night as not every pair need make themselves eligible — any game with at least three tables can generate qualifiers.

Blue points are awarded in the heats, with Green points available in regional and national finals.

Heats must be completed by mid-February so if you are interested then ask your club secretary or chairman to look on <u>our website</u> or contact <u>Peter Jordan</u> on 01296 317203.

This list has some of the clubs which are hosting heats. If you intend playing somewhere other than your regular club please check that they are accepting visitors on that night. If you know of a heat which isn't listed please let us know.

BBO Online Tournaments

The EBU continues to run games on <u>Bridge Base Online (BBO)</u>. They are open to anyone, not just EBU members, although they are specifically aimed towards our members by issuing EBU masterpoints and using EBU regulations.

The games are every Wednesday at 2pm and 4pm, every Saturday at 4pm, and every Sunday at 4pm, 6pm and 9pm. There will not be a game on Christmas Day, but there will be games on 28^{th} and 29^{th} December.
