



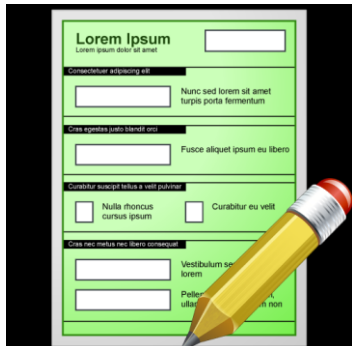
# EBU Event Focus

## RANKED MASTERS PAIRS

22 – 23 February 2014 - Park Inn, Northampton

This is a group of pairs championships for which an appropriate EBU Master Point Rank is needed to enter and you will compete against those in the same ranking category.

There are six categories, ranging from Premier Grand Masters to Regional Masters. Full details of each category can be seen on the website.

Those ranked below Regional Master should enter the Masters Pairs (see below).

All events will start at 2pm on Saturday and end between 3:30pm and 5:30pm on Sunday (the exact finishing time will depend on the number of players in each competition).

23 February 2014 – multiple venues

This event is played as a 2-session, 1-day event scored by match-points simultaneously across several centres.

It is open to players below the rank of Regional Master: Local Masters, Club Masters, Area Masters, District Masters, County Masters, Masters, Advanced Masters, Star Masters, Tournament Masters or Premier Masters.

This popular congress moves to York for one year only. Make the most of the opportunity to play bridge in the city of the Minster and The Shambles.

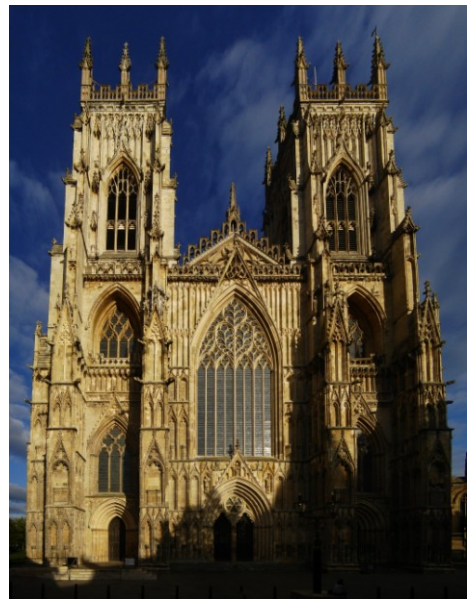
There is a pairs event on the first afternoon, a three-session Swiss Pairs across the first evening and second day, and finishes with a Swiss Teams on the final day.

Both Swiss events are fully Green Pointed. The Mixed/Open Pairs are Blue Pointed on the national congress scale.

The closing date for entries is 12th February 2014 but early entry is advised as this congress may be full before that date.

23 March 2014- multiple venues

**A two-session Mixed Pairs event held at various venues around the country**

This event is played in fifteen venues in England and Wales and is match-pointed over the entire field via the internet.

This is an ideal opportunity to play in a nationwide competition with only a minimal amount of travel required. Green points are awarded.

There are two sessions of 24 boards, starting at noon, and with a second session later in the afternoon.

This includes the Open, Senior and Women's teams, but also, importantly, the junior squads – the next generation of bridge players. The Bridge England Sim Pairs therefore not only supports our successful international teams, but also helps keep the whole English game in good health. We hope that you will support the event.

**New prize structure:** As per the new 2014 prize structure, each club which hosts a heat will have the chance to win up to £1000. The winning pair of each heat will also have the chance to win up to £1000.

### EBU Online Games Prize Competition

A new Prize Competition for our online games will begin on Saturday 1st February.

The player which accumulates the most BBO masterpoints in our games in any calendar month will receive BB\$20. Second place will receive BB\$10. In the event of a tie for any position the prize will be shared.

This will reward those who are successful on a regular basis and hopefully gives an added incentive to those who play infrequently, or are thinking of playing for the first time. The competition is open to everyone, so you can encourage your friends to take part even if they are not EBU members.

This competition will run alongside the award of EBU masterpoints, so you can still accumulate those even if you are not in the running for the monthly prize.

You can also see a list of the all-time highest points scorers [here](#) – whilst there is no prize for being top of this list we hope that moving up the list, and striving for the top spot, will be an added incentive for you all.

From 1<sup>st</sup> February the EBU games are on [Bridge Base Online \(BBO\)](#) every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday at 4pm, every Saturday at 4pm, and every Sunday at 4pm, 6pm and 9pm.

If you wish to enter the National Pairs your club can host a heat. Heats can be hosted by any EBU affiliated club, and the heats can be part of an ordinary club night as not every pair need make themselves eligible – any game with at least three tables can generate qualifiers.

Blue points are awarded in the heats, with Green points available in regional and national finals. Those qualifying from their club heats will be eligible to play in the Regional Finals on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> March.

Heats must be completed by mid-February so if you are interested then ask your club secretary or chairman to look on [our website](#) or contact [Peter Jordan](#) on 01296 317203.
