## EASTER FESTIVALS OF BRIDGE

**Join us at Easter for a full weekend of bridge at our two congresses**

### **Easter Festival, London**

*18 – 21 April 2014*

A full programme of bridge across the holiday weekend, with events suited to everyone's standard. The Championship Pairs is on Friday and Saturday, with a stratified Swiss Teams on Sunday and a flighted Swiss Pairs on Monday.

On Friday afternoon there is also the Really Easy Afternoon, a relaxed duplicate pairs event for those with less experience, intended as an introduction to 'congress bridge'. This is unlikely to be suitable for any recipients of Event Focus, but we hope you will have friends or family for whom it would be ideal.

On Saturday afternoon is the Under 19 Pairs Championships, for those born after 1<sup>st</sup> January 1995.

The event takes place at the Royal National Hotel in London, close to Russell Square.

## THE SCHAPIRO SPRING FOURSOMES

2 – 6 May 2014 – Stratford-upon-Avon

**Play against some of the best players in the world in one of England's best events**

The Schapiro Spring Foursomes is one of the great events in the English calendar, and arguably one of the toughest in domestic bridge.

It draws a field full of some of the best players in English and World bridge, and this year is no exception. Maria-Teresa Lavazza has entered her world champions - Giorgio Duboin, Agustin Madala, Noberto Bocchi, and Argentinian star, Alejandro Bianchedi – and they join World Champion Eric Saelensminde from Norway, Sabine Auken and Roy Welland, of the German team, Zia Mahmood and Marion Michielsen on the entry list. Add the majority of the recent English Venice Cup, Bermuda Bowl, Camrose and Lady Milne teams, and numerous other international players, and you have a star-studded field.



The event is run on double-elimination lines over nine sessions each of 32 boards. A secondary event, the Punchbowl, is open to teams eliminated before Sunday evening. It has a round-robin qualifier followed by a mini knockout. The Hamilton Cup is a more relaxed event for teams seeking a game on Bank Holiday Monday.

Due to generous sponsorship from Mrs Helen Schapiro, prizes are approximately twice the normal EBU value.

**Lunchtime Speedballs now added to the schedule**

Lunchtime speedballs have been added to the schedule, starting on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> April. The games will begin at 1pm, and twelve boards will be played in 54 minutes – ideal for during your lunch hour.

These have been added to the schedule of games which take place on five days of the week:

Tuesday at 1pm (speedball) and 4pm  
Wednesday at 1pm (speedball) and 4pm  
Thursday at 1pm (speedball) and 4pm  
Saturday at 4pm (with IMPs scoring)  
Sunday at 4pm, 6pm and 9pm

The games are open to everyone (not just EBU members) and Master Points are awarded.

### Monthly Competition

The player who accumulates the most BBO Masterpoints in our games in each calendar month will receive BB\$20. Second place will receive BB\$10.

The competition is open to everyone, including non-EBU members and those overseas, and hopefully gives an added incentive to those who play infrequently, or are thinking of playing for the first time.

A new competition started on 1<sup>st</sup> April, but you can join at any point during the month. You can also try to move up the overall point winners list, and whilst there is no prize for this there is significant kudos so in addition to earning EBU Master Points there is an incentive to take part even if you are not in the running for the monthly prize.



## THE HUBERT PHILLIPS BOWL

2014/15 entries now open

**Entries are now open for the mixed teams-of-four championships of England.**

This mixed teams-of-four championship is played on the full pivot principle such that one plays one-third of the match with each teammate as a partner.

Teams may contain 4, 5 or 6 players, but only 4 players may play in any given match prior to the semi-final stage, and at no time may an all-male or all-female team be playing.

The scoring is by aggregate with honours counting, so this is an ideal tournament for new players to the game of duplicate from rubber or Chicago bridge.

The event is a knock-out format, with a Plate competition for early loser so that all non-seeded teams play at least two matches. Teams are seeded in the Bowl competition so that every team entering is guaranteed at least one match before meeting a seed.

The draw for the early rounds is regionalized to try to help keep travelling distances small.

The closing date for entries is 18<sup>th</sup> April 2014.
