



EBU Event Focus Issue 31: May 2015



As you may know, the EBU Board has made the decision that the Summer Meeting in 2016 and beyond will be moving from Brighton to Eastbourne.

This decision is based on a number of factors, and takes in to account the feedback received from members in the survey which was undertaken late last year. The move to Eastbourne addresses a number of concerns expressed during the survey – in particular the cost and availability of accommodation and parking in Brighton – whilst maintaining the ‘holiday resort’ location which was appealing to the majority of the respondents. The new venue will also lead to a reduction in the cost of holding the event, and this will be passed on through a reduction in the entry fees. More details on these prices will be available in 2016.

We hope that the move to Eastbourne will be a great success, and the event will be well supported, but that does not mean we aren't determined to make the 2015 Summer Meeting the best it can be. We will continue to provide the high quality competitions, lectures, and training courses which you have come to expect at the Summer Meeting, and hope that you will join us to say a fond farewell to Brighton. SPRING BANK HOLIDAY CONGRESS *23rd - 25th May, Stratford-upon-Avon*

Join us for a weekend of bridge in Shakespeare's home town

A relaxed congress now to be held in Stratford-upon-Avon (previously in Bournemouth). Stratford provides plenty of entertainment for the free mornings, or players may wish to spend an extra night there in order to go to the theatre.

Saturday sees the start of the Championship Pairs, with the top forty pairs playing in all-play-all finals on Sunday. The non-qualifiers play in a Swiss Pairs on Sunday, an event which is also open to those playing on Sunday only. Monday is a stratified Swiss Teams event.

Change of schedule
