#### **NATIONAL PAIRS**

#### Changes to the format

We want to remind you of changes to the format of the National Pairs for 2015/16.

The first stage will be Regional Finals, held at an increased number of venues (see <a href="here">here</a> for the locations). There will not be any club heats. All venues will play the same boards and the event scored across the entire field. The top 50 pairs nationally will qualify to play in the National Final. In addition the venues will be divided into regions, with each region scored by itself, and the winning pairs awarded 'regional trophies'.

We hope this will encourage greater interest in the event and lead to a National Final of quality.

The National Pairs is an event in the Championship Series, in which points can be earned towards the <u>Player of the Year</u> Championship (see below).

#### **SIM PAIRS EVENTS**

The next Sim Pairs event is the British Summer Sim Pairs - Monday 27th to Thursday 30th July.

Please take part encourage your club to host a heat - they can enter up until the evening before.

There are many reasons to take part in our Sim Pairs:

Win £1000: every heat winner is entered into a draw with a top prize of £1000. There are 17 other prizes, and the same prizes for host clubs too.

**Enhanced Master Points:** the leading pairs win enhanced Master Points, including Blue Points, whilst playing at their 'regular club night'.

An online results srvice which includes: **commentaries by experts**; a **double dummy** analysis feature; a comments **board** so you can discuss hands with other participants.
