The London event includes a three session Championship Pairs, a flighted Swiss Pairs and a Stratified Swiss Teams. An early start is available on Friday for the Championships Pairs - if you wish to start at 2pm rather than the standard 4pm please let us know when entering.

The Northern Easter Festival, run by the Yorkshire CBA on the EBU's behalf, starts with an Open Pairs and a Mixed Pairs competition, continues with a three session Swiss Pairs, and ends with a Swiss Teams. They will also host an improver pairs which is part of the Really Easy Afternoon.

Under 21 Championship Pairs

This event is part of the Easter Festival in London and takes place on Saturday 26th March. Entry is free (please enter in advance), and players also gain free entry to the Swiss Teams on Sunday, and half price entry to the Swiss Pairs on Monday. Players should be born more recently than 26th March 1995. Play starts at noon, and should finish around 6:30pm.

25th March, multiple venues

INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

World Mixed Teams

We are accepting applications from teams hoping to be the English representatives in the Mixed Teams event at the World Bridge Games. The EBU may subsidise the entry fee for the event, but otherwise the team would be self-funded.

Teams comprised of two or three mixed pairs should submit their application to dawn@ebu.co.uk before 13th March. The selection committee reserves the right to hold a trial, or to select the team, according to the entries received. Should a trial be held, it will take place on 14th & 15th May (an entry fee would be charged).

The World Bridge Games takes place in Wroclaw, Poland, from 3rd - 17th September 2016.

European Youth Pairs

The 13th European Youth Pairs Championships are due to be held in Liepaja, Latvia, from 13th to 20th July 2016. The planned schedule is:

13th & 14th July – Mixed pairs (U26)

15th -17th July – Pairs (U26, U26 women, U21 and U16) 18th – 20th July – Youth Bridge Camp

Pairs who would like to be nominated to represent England in the event should apply to their squad leader or dawn@ebu.co.uk by March 31st. The EBU may be able to provide a subsidy towards playing in this event, although priority will be given to players in the junior squads. Applications are welcome from all interested pairs.
