National Point-a-Board Teams

20th - 21st January, London

Held at the Young Chelsea Bridge Club, this competition is played exclusively on the point-a-board (BAM) format - a great opportunity to play with this fascinating and skillful, but rare, form of scoring.

The event was full last year so don't wait too long to enter this year.

There will be qualifying sessions on Saturday, with carry-forwards for qualifying teams. On Sunday there will be a main final for the top teams with longer head-to-head matches, and a consolation final for non-qualifiers.

Master Points will be awarded at a **50% enhanced rate** for matches won in the qualifier and main final, and points can be earned towards the **Player of the Year Championship**.
