All files must be supplied in CMYK colour space, along with all fonts and images embedded in High resolution PDFs. Crop marks and bleed (where applicable) must be included. Files must be full size and of high resolution. Images must be at least 300dpi.

## Summary of Terms and Conditions for the acceptance of Advertising.

The advertiser is responsible for ensuring the advertisement complies with any legal or regulatory requirements. The publisher reserves the right to suspend any advertisement deemed as in breach of the requirements, without breach of contract. Any production work deemed necessary to bring any advertisements to the publisher's required format will be charged for.

An advertiser may change the size or shape of an advertisement, or cancel an advertisement by giving notice in writing not less than 12 weeks before copy date.
