

EBU Privacy Policy

The term “English Bridge Union” or “EBU” or “us” or “we” refers to the owner of the website whose registered office is English Bridge Union, Broadfields, Bicester Road, Aylesbury, Bucks, and HP19 8AZ. The term “you” refers to the user or viewer of our website.

What we collect

We may collect the following information:

- name
- contact information including email address
- demographic information such as post code, preferences and interests

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

Security

Thawte has checked and verified the company registration documents and the site's registered domain name. Once an e-business has obtained a Thawte SSL certificate, Thawte supplies the customer with the Thawte Trusted Site Seal to upload onto their website. By clicking on the Thawte Trusted Site Seal, visitors will get real-time confirmation of the validity of the certificate on the web server to which they are connected.

How we use cookies
