## Seniors Pairs Championship

## Semi Finals

Main Semi Final will be 11 tables, consisting of the top 22 pairs from the qualifier. There will be a carry-forward of $50 \%$ of the qualifier score. Starting positions will be displayed.

The secondary Semi Final will be 7 tables, played by the remaining 14 pairs, with no carry forward. Draw for starting positions.

## Finals

The A and B finals will be 5-table, all-play-all events. Starting positions will be displayed.

From the main Semi Final, the top 9 pairs will qualify for the $A$ final and the next 6 pairs will qualify for the $B$ final. The carryforward to the A final for these pairs is $50 \%$ of their percentage score from the semi-final (including the earlier carry-forward).

From the secondary Semi Final, the top pair will qualify for the A final and the next 4 pairs will qualify for the $B$ final. The carry-forward to the $A$ final is $2 / 3$ of the pair's percentage score in the Semi-Final, subject to a cap of the carry-forward of the $5^{\text {th }}$ placed team in the main Semi Final and a 'collar' of what would have been the carry-forward of the $10^{\text {th }}$ placed team in the main Semi Final.

The remaining pairs from both Semi Finals play in the consolation final. Draw for starting positions.

There is no carry-forward to the B final or the consolation final.
