

Friday 2nd to Sunday 4th October 2020

For obvious reasons we are unable to hold our annual County Congress live this year, but it will be run online instead using the Bridge Base Online (BBO) platform and as far as possible it will replicate the traditional format:-

Friday 2nd October: Relaxed Pairs 19:00 to 22:00 – 20 boards played at a leisurely pace for novices and less experienced players, with written hand commentary.

Saturday 3rd October: Pairs, with qualifying in the first session (10:00 to 13:00) followed by finals in the afternnon (14:30 to 18:00). Green Pointed.

Sunday 4th October: Swiss Teams. 6 x 8 board matches (10:00 to 13:20 and 15:00 to 18:20). Green Pointed.

Players must be registered with BBO; this is very simple to do but help is available from SCBA if necessary.

Friday 2nd October – RELAXED PAIRS

An event especially for novices and less experience players; 20 boards played at a relaxed pace with written hand commentary for later analysis. Entry is via Bridge Base Online (BBO) and players will need to set up an account (free) and credit it with sufficient funds to cover the entry fee; this is quite simple to do but help from SCBA is available if required.


